

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

Monday 18/09/2023

On 18/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To add a new clause requiring that a Minister publish an assessment of the impact of the enforcement of sections of the Vagrancy Act 1824 on levelling-up and regeneration.

This was defeat number 120 in the parliamentary session.
