

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 18/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To add a new clause requiring the Government to keep a register of schools and hospitals in serious disrepair.

This was defeat number 121 in the parliamentary session.
