

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

Monday 18/09/2023

On 18/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To make provision for Clause 59 of the Bill (consent to conferral of police and crime commissioner functions on mayor) to come into force nine months after royal assent.

This was defeat number 124 in the parliamentary session.
