

Government Defeat in Lords on National Security Bill

Wednesday 21/06/2023

On 21/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the National Security Bill: To insist on adding a new clause requiring political parties to provide an annual statement to the Electoral Commission setting out individually the details of all donations from a foreign power (whether directly or through an intermediary).

This was defeat number 54 in the parliamentary session.
