

Government Defeat in Lords on National Security Bill

On 21/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the National Security Bill: To insist on adding a new clause requiring the Prime Minister to review the memorandum of understanding with the Intelligence and Security Committee in light of any changes resulting from the Act.

This was defeat number 55 in the parliamentary session.
