

Government Defeat in Lords on National Security Bill

Tuesday 07/03/2023

On 07/03/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the National Security Bill: To add a new clause to require the Prime Minister to update the memorandum of understanding with the Intelligence and Security Committee to reflect any changes to intelligence or security activities resulting from the Act.

This was defeat number 23 in the parliamentary session.
