

Government Defeat in Lords on National Security Bill

Wednesday 01/03/2023

On 01/03/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the National Security Bill: To add a new clause requiring political parties to publish policy statements to ensure the identification of donations from foreign powers (whether directly or indirectly) and to require parties to provide annual statements to the Electoral Commission on risk management relating to donations from foreign powers.

This was defeat number 22 in the parliamentary session.
