

Government Defeat in Lords on Northern Ireland Troubles (Legacy and Reconciliation) Bill

Monday 26/06/2023

On 26/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Northern Ireland Troubles (Legacy and Reconciliation) Bill: To establish minimum standards for a “review” conducted by the Independent Commission for Reconciliation and Information Recovery to ensure conduct is investigated to criminal justice standards.

This was defeat number 56 in the parliamentary session.
