

Government Defeat in Lords on Northern Ireland Troubles (Legacy and Reconciliation) Bill

Monday 26/06/2023

On 26/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Northern Ireland Troubles (Legacy and Reconciliation) Bill: To remove a clause that would have allowed a person to request immunity from prosecution as part of the ICRIR's investigations of Troubles-related conduct.

This was defeat number 57 in the parliamentary session.
