

# Government Defeat in Lords on Online Safety Bill

Wednesday 19/07/2023

On 19/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Online Safety Bill: To include user-to-user services in Category 1 and Category 2B regulated services if either a number of users condition or a functionality condition is met, rather than requiring both to be met.

This was defeat number 102 in the parliamentary session.
