

Government Defeat in Lords on Online Safety Bill

Monday 10/07/2023

On 10/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Online Safety Bill: To require “children’s risk assessments” of user-to-user services to consider the potential for the design and operation of services to create harm separately and additionally to the harm of disseminating or encountering of harmful content.

This was defeat number 82 in the parliamentary session.
