

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Act 1986 (Serious Disruption to the Life of the Community) Regulations 2023

Tuesday 13/06/2023

On 13/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Act 1986 (Serious Disruption to the Life of the Community) Regulations 2023: To regret that the government has brought forwards measures in the regulations that were recently rejected in primary legislation and to call for the government to withdraw the regulations (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 48 in the parliamentary session.
