# Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

# Tuesday 28/03/2023

On 28/03/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To require officers to provide their name and badge number when conducting a stop and search and to require police forces to establish a charter on the use of stop and search, provide annual figures on use by location and publicise reasons for use.

This was defeat number 26 in the parliamentary session.
