Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

Tuesday 14/03/2023

On 14/03/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To raise the rank required to authorise stop and search without suspicion to chief superintendent, remove intentional public nuisance as a criteria, limit the time of authorisation to 12 hours and require that the public be informed of authorisation.

This was defeat number 24 in the parliamentary session.
