

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

Tuesday 14/03/2023

On 14/03/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To insist with revision on requiring a Chief Superintendent to authorise stop and search without suspicion, remove intentional public nuisance as a criterion, limit authorisation to 12 hours and require that the public be informed.

This was defeat number 24 in the parliamentary session.
