

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

Tuesday 28/03/2023

On 28/03/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To insist (x2) with revision on requiring officers to provide their identification when conducting a stop and search and to require police forces to establish a charter, provide annual figures by location and publicise reasons for use of stop and search.

This was defeat number 26 in the parliamentary session.
