

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

On 07/02/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To remove a clause granting police powers to stop and search without suspicion in an area where an officer believes an offence may be committed.

This was defeat number 16 in the parliamentary session.
