

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

On 07/02/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To reject a government amendment to add a new clause amending section 12 of the Public Order Act 1986. The amendment would have made a provision about when a public procession in England and Wales may result in serious disruption to the life of the community.

This was defeat number 17 in the parliamentary session.
