

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

Tuesday 07/02/2023

On 07/02/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To limit the trigger events for issuing a serious disruption prevention order, so that provisions for contributing to actions committed by other individuals that are protest-related offences or that breach injunctions are removed.

This was defeat number 20 in the parliamentary session.
