

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

On 07/02/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Public Order Bill: To remove a clause allowing a magistrates court to issue a serious disruption order in cases other than as part of a conviction.

This was defeat number 21 in the parliamentary session.
