

Government Defeat in Lords on Public Order Bill

On 30/01/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment which it supported on the Public Order Bill: To limit the scope of claiming "protesting an issue of current debate" as a reasonable excuse defence for actions covered in the bill.

This was defeat number 15 in the parliamentary session.
