

Government Defeat in Lords on Representation of the People (Overseas Electors etc.) (Amendment) Regulations 2023

Tuesday 12/12/2023

On 12/12/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Representation of the People (Overseas Electors etc.) (Amendment) Regulations 2023: To regret that the draft regulations could dangerously weaken the restrictions on overseas political donations and allow foreign money to enter British democracy (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 4 in the parliamentary session.
