Government Defeat in Lords on Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill

On 20/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill: To insist that regulations may only be made using powers in the act if the relevant national authority is satisfied that environmental protections are not reduced and that they must seek independent advice on the matter.

This was defeat number 49 in the parliamentary session.
