# Government Defeat in Lords on Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill

# Tuesday 06/06/2023

On 06/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill: To insist on adding a new clause requiring that regulations made by a relevant national authority relating to environmental protection must not reduce environmental protections and must not conflict with UK international agreements.

This was defeat number 40 in the parliamentary session.
