Government Defeat in Lords on Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill

On 06/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill: To insist on adding a new clause requiring that regulations made by ministers must be laid before parliament with the possibility of amendment and referred to a House of Commons committee that can require a debate and vote on the regulations.

This was defeat number 41 in the parliamentary session.
