

Government Defeat in Lords on Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill

Tuesday 20/06/2023

On 20/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill: To insist (x2) on referring regulations that revoke EU secondary legislation to a Committee of the House of Commons that may require a debate in both Houses on the regulations and may require a resolution from the Commons to lay the regulations.

This was defeat number 50 in the parliamentary session.
