

Government Defeat in Lords on Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill

Monday 15/05/2023

On 15/05/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill: To remove a clause and insert a new clause to allow Parliament and the devolved legislatures to prevent the revocation of any particular retained EU rights, powers and liabilities due to be revoked automatically at the end of 2023.

This was defeat number 37 in the parliamentary session.
