

Government Defeat in Lords on Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill

Monday 15/05/2023

On 15/05/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill: To provide for the Schedule of retained EU law to be revoked to be referred to a Joint Committee of both Houses for sifting so that any revocation leading to substantial changes in UK law must be debated and voted on by each House.

This was defeat number 36 in the parliamentary session.
