

Government Defeat in Lords on Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill

Wednesday 17/05/2023

On 17/05/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Bill: To provide for new regulations created using powers in the Act to be referred to a Joint Committee of both Houses for sifting so that any new regulations leading to substantial changes in UK law must be debated and voted on by each House.

This was defeat number 39 in the parliamentary session.
