

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

Tuesday 16/04/2024

On 16/04/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To insist (x2) on ensuring that the final Act is compliant with international law, the Children Act 1989, the Human Rights Act 1998, and the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

This was defeat number 30 in the parliamentary session.
