

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

Wednesday 17/04/2024

On 17/04/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To insist (x3) on adding a new clause to exempt individuals who have supported UK overseas forces, and the families of those individuals, from removal to Rwanda.

This was defeat number 35 in the parliamentary session.
