

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

Monday 22/04/2024

On 22/04/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To insist (x4) on requiring the Secretary of State to lay before parliament a report by the independent Monitoring Committee when the Rwanda Treaty has been implemented and to update parliament if the provisions of the treaty are later not adhered to.

This was defeat number 36 in the parliamentary session.
