

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

On 20/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To insist on ensuring that the final Act is fully compliant with the rule of law.

This was defeat number 23 in the parliamentary session.
