

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

Wednesday 20/03/2024

On 20/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To insist on giving effect to the proposition that parliament cannot judge Rwanda to be a safe country until the Rwanda Treaty has been, and continues to be, fully implemented.

This was defeat number 24 in the parliamentary session.
