Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

On 20/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To insist on adding a new clause to require that victims of modern slavery and human trafficking are not removed to Rwanda without their consent.

This was defeat number 28 in the parliamentary session.
