

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

On 04/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To remove sections from the bill that would have limited the ability of courts and tribunals to consider a review of, or an appeal against, a decision relating to the removal of a person to Rwanda.

This was defeat number 11 in the parliamentary session.
