

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

Wednesday 06/03/2024

On 06/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To replace a clause to reinstate the ability of decision makers to consider whether Rwanda is a safe country in individual cases and to allow domestic courts and tribunals to grant interim relief in such cases.

This was defeat number 12 in the parliamentary session.
