

# Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

Wednesday 06/03/2024

On 06/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To add a new clause disapplying section 57 of Illegal Migration Act 2023, which limits judicial review of decisions made on the basis of age assessment of unaccompanied children, in relation to removals to Rwanda.

This was defeat number 13 in the parliamentary session.
