# Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

Wednesday 06/03/2024

On 06/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To add a new clause requiring the publication of a timetable for the Government's plans to remove asylum cases accrued under the provisions of the Illegal Migration Act 2023 to Rwanda.

This was defeat number 14 in the parliamentary session.
