

Government Defeat in Lords on Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill

On 04/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Safety of Rwanda (Asylum and Immigration) Bill: To allow the presumption that Rwanda is a safe country to be rebutted by credible evidence presented to decision-makers, including courts and tribunals.

This was defeat number 10 in the parliamentary session.
