

# Government Defeat in Lords on Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill

Thursday 08/06/2023

On 08/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill: To insist on removing the requirement that unions take reasonable steps to ensure that members comply with work notices.

This was defeat number 46 in the parliamentary session.
