

Government Defeat in Lords on Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill

On 04/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill: To insist (x2) that the Secretary of State must publish draft regulations, conduct an impact assessment, consult with relevant parties and provide reports to a Joint Committee who must publish a review before minimum service regulations can be made.

This was defeat number 76 in the parliamentary session.
