

Government Defeat in Lords on Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill

Wednesday 26/04/2023

On 26/04/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill: To prevent failure to comply with a work notice from being regarded as a breach of contract or constituting lawful grounds for dismissal.

This was defeat number 33 in the parliamentary session.
