

Government Defeat in Lords on Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill

On 26/04/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Strikes (Minimum Service Levels) Bill: To limit the application of the Act to England only.

This was defeat number 35 in the parliamentary session.
