

Government Defeat in Lords on Victims and Prisoners Bill

Tuesday 30/04/2024

On 30/04/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Victims and Prisoners Bill: To add a new clause requiring public authorities to act in the public interest and with transparency, candour and frankness when carrying out their duties in relation to major incidents.

This was defeat number 40 in the parliamentary session.
