

# Government Defeat in Lords on Victims and Prisoners Bill

Tuesday 21/05/2024

On 21/05/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Victims and Prisoners Bill: To add a new clause adding a condition of the release and licence of serial and serious harm domestic abuse and stalking perpetrators that they must be included in the Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements.

This was defeat number 42 in the parliamentary session.
