

# Government Defeat in Lords on Victims and Prisoners Bill

Tuesday 21/05/2024

On 21/05/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Victims and Prisoners Bill: To add a new clause adding a condition of the release and licence of serial and serious harm domestic abuse and stalking perpetrators that they must be subject to notification requirements under the Sexual Offences Act 2003.

This was defeat number 43 in the parliamentary session.
