Government Defeat in Lords on Victims and Prisoners Bill

On 23/04/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Victims and Prisoners Bill: To add a new clause to create a duty for specified public authorities, including criminal justice bodies, the Parole Board and police forces, to collaborate with the Victims and Witnesses Commissioner.

This was defeat number 37 in the parliamentary session.
