

Government Defeat in Lords on Victims and Prisoners Bill

Tuesday 23/04/2024

On 23/04/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Victims and Prisoners Bill: To add a new clause to require the Secretary of State to publish and implement a strategy for mandatory training for staff at the relevant justice agencies responsible for giving effect to the Victims Code.

This was defeat number 38 in the parliamentary session.
