

Government Defeat in Lords on Victims and Prisoners Bill

On 30/04/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Victims and Prisoners Bill: To add a new clause to ensure that the personal data of a victim of a crime is not used for any immigration control purpose without the consent of that person.

This was defeat number 39 in the parliamentary session.
